### **Scholarship Information**

We are pleased to announce the availability of a limited number of scholarships for Lifeguarding and/or CPR certification courtesy of a grant from Gundersen Health System. These scholarships are intended for individuals with financial need, and are open to YMCA members and community members. Applications will require financial documentation or a statement of non-filing from the IRS, and applied for through our Financial Assistance Program.

Both our CPR/AED/First Aid class and our Lifeguarding class are blended formats, with an online portion that must be completed prior to attending the in-person section of the class. The online portion must be taken on a PC or tablet with a high speed Internet connection. If computer or internet access are a barrier for you, please let us know during the application process.

#### **CPR certification details:**

 This course will prepare you to recognize and care for a variety of first aid, breathing, and cardiac emergencies involving adults and infants and meets OSHA/workplace requirements. This is a blended learning course including an online portion and an instructor-led classroom skill session. Allow approximately 2-3 hours to complete the online portion. Upon successful completion of this course you will receive a digital certificate for Adult & Pediatric First Aid/CPR/AED valid for two years.

#### Lifeguard certification details:

 This course will prepare you to recognize and care for a variety of land and water emergencies and how to respond to them. This is a blended learning course including an online portion and an instructor-led classroom skill session. Allow approximately 7-8 hours to complete the online portion. The in-person portion will take approximately 20 hours over a weekend. Upon successful completion of this course you will receive a digital certificate for Lifeguarding valid for two years.

#### Lifeguard prerequisites:

- Must be a least 15 years old
- Swim 300 yards continuously using the breast stroke or front crawl
- Tread water for 2 minutes using only the legs
- Complete a timed retrieval event within 1 minute and 40 seconds:
  - Start in the water and swim 25 yards. Surface dive to a depth of 7–10 feet to retrieve a 10-pound object. Return to the surface and swim on your back to return to the starting point. Exit the water without using a ladder or steps.
